U10 born in 2017 - **U11** born in 2016

U12 born in 2015 - **U13** born in 2014 - **U14** born in 2013 - **U15** born in 2012

U10 - U11 - U12 - 8 v 8 half field

U13 - U14 - U15 - 11 v 11 full field

Per age category, 3 players may be 1 year older.

Teams play at least 6 matches of 1x 20/25 minutes in 2 days.

U10 - U11 - U12 - 6 x 20 minutes

U13 - U14 - U15 - 6 x 25 minutes

All players receive a medal & the top 3 teams also receive a trophy.

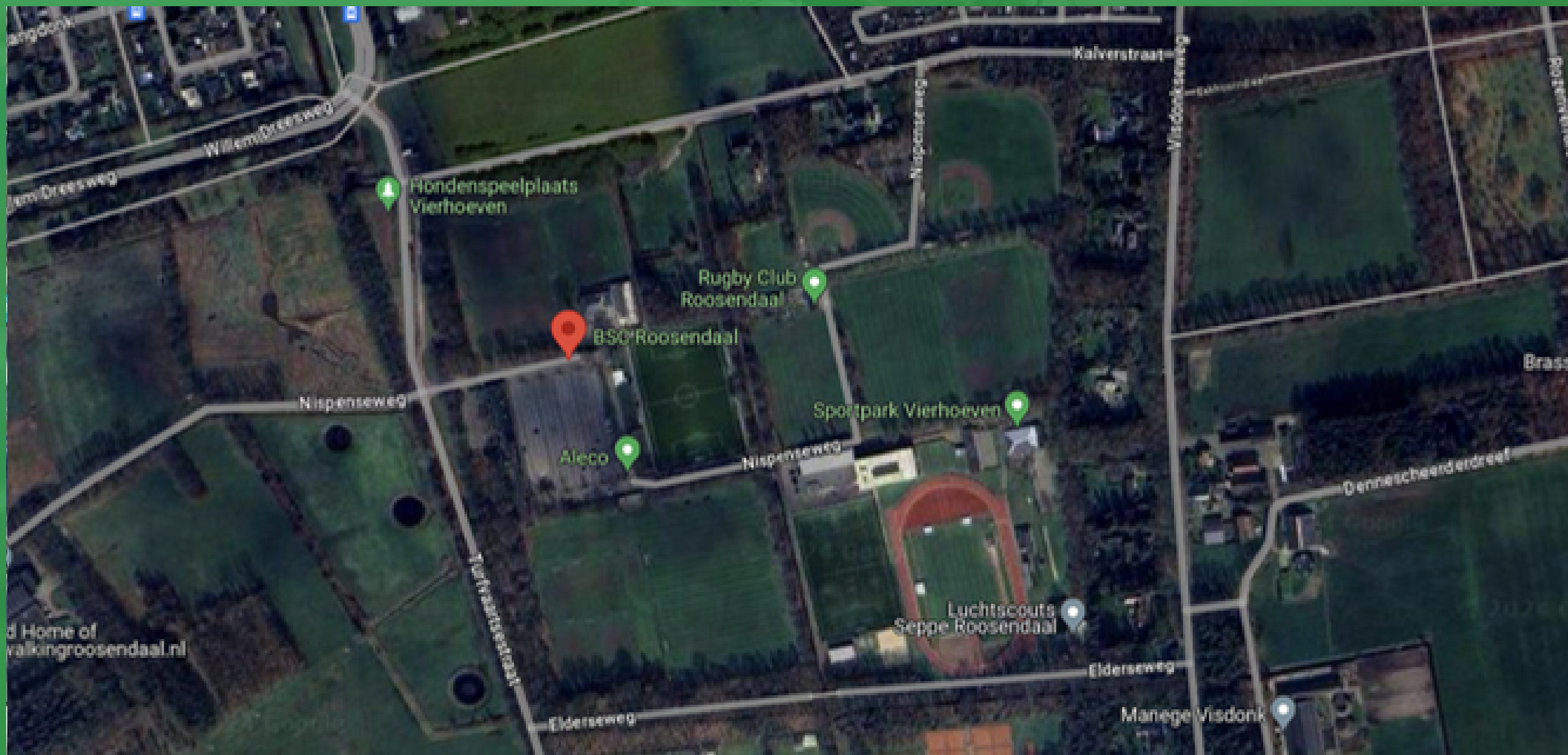

Parents or guardians are welcome to accompany their child on the trip, and there are options available for additional companion costs.

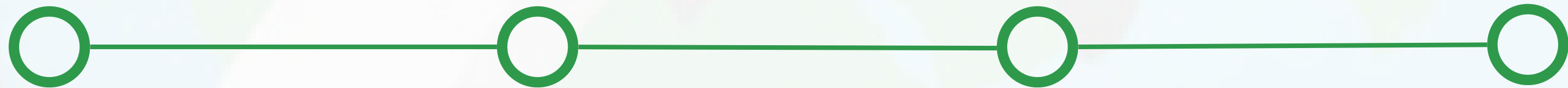
However, it is also perfectly fine if parents choose to make their own arrangements.
